Triangle North Vance site:

This 422-acre park in Vance County has been located at exit 209 on I-85, across from Vance-Granville Community College. The site is controlled by Triangle North and certified by N.C. Department of Commerce. Conveniently located half an hour north of Durham, it is less than 45 minutes from the heart of Research Triangle Park and only 48 miles to the state capital in Raleigh.
